Day 1: Wednesday, March 18, 2026

Evening departure from San Francisco International Airport

Day 2: Thursday, March 19, 2026

Arrive at **Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport.** Meet your EDU Trips guide and board the chartered buses to travel to the hotel (approximately 40 minutes). Check into your rooms and freshen up.

10:00 AM Board bus to visit the Buda Castle District district Visit the **Buda Castle** and stroll through the majestic courtyards and terraces of this UNESCO World Heritage site. Then visit the **Budapest History Museum**, which tells the story of Budapest's rich and complex history, from Roman times to modern-day, through engaging exhibits, interactive displays, and real castle ruins in the basement. Students will get a sense of how wars, politics, and revolutions shaped the city.

01:00 PM Enjoy lunch on your own at **Central Market Hall**, the city's largest and oldest indoor market, offering a rich blend of history, architecture, and local culture. Enjoy a free afternoon of shopping on Váci Utca Shopping Street

02:30 PM Visit **Citadella Fortress and Liberty Statue** Drive up Gellért Hill to the Citadella fortress for panoramic views of the Danube, Buda, and Pest. Visit the iconic Liberty Statue, originally erected in 1947, which now stands as a powerful symbol of peace and Hungary's resilience.

o6:00 PM Enjoy dinner with the group at a local restaurant. **o8:00 PM** Return to the hotel and retire for the evening









Day 4: Saturday, March 21, 2026 - Hungarian Parliament and St. Stephen's Basilica

og:oo AM Enjoy breakfast at the hotel

10:00 AM Hungarian Parliament Building.

Tour one of Europe's most stunning government buildings, home to Hungary's Holy Crown and the National Assembly. Learn about Hungary's political history, national identity, and legislative process in an unforgettable setting.

12:00 PM Walk across **Széchenyi Chain Bridge** (Iconic suspension bridge connecting Buda and Pest).

01:00 PM Lunch at **WestEnd City Center** (cost not included)

o3:30 PM Visit the **St. Stephen's Basilica**, the largest church in Budapest, known for its magnificent dome and the preserved right hand of Hungary's first king, St. Stephen. Students can climb to the observation deck for breathtaking city views.

o6:oo PM Enjoy dinner with the group at a local restaurant.o8:oo PM Return to the hotel and retire for the evening









Day 5: Sunday, March 22, 2026 - Danube Bend Hiking Excursion

10:00 AM Board bus to travel to **Normafa**. Enjoy a hike and breathtaking panoramic views of Budapest from this scenic hilltop trail in the Buda Hills — a peaceful escape into nature. Easy-to-moderate trails make it ideal for student groups; fresh air, forest paths, and a taste of Hungary's natural beauty.

12:30 PM Enjoy lunch on your own at Allee Shopping Center


o2:00 PM Enjoy the Cave Walking Tour at the Buda Castle. Discover the hidden underground world beneath Buda Castle, filled with natural limestone caves, wartime shelters, and medieval legends. Learn how these caves were used for everything from wine storage to secret military operations — a unique and atmospheric experience for students.

04:00 PM Free time in Budapest

<u>Day 6: Monday, March 24, 2026 - Széchenyi Thermal Baths, House of Terror Museum and Dohány Street Synagogue</u>

08:00 AM Enjoy breakfast at the hotel

og:30 AM Depart for **Széchenyi Thermal Baths**, one of Europe's largest and most renowned spa complexes, offering a blend of relaxation and architectural grandeur.

12:00 PM Return to the hotel to change

01:00 PM Depart the hotel for lunch at **Arena Mall**.

03:00 PM House of Terror Museum

Walk through chilling exhibits that document Hungary's experience under Nazi and Communist regimes, located in the former secret police headquarters. Powerful audio-visual displays and real artifacts make this a thought-provoking and emotionally impactful visit.

04:30 PM Visit the **Dohány Street Synagogue** architectural landmark that honors Hungary's rich Jewish heritage. Explore the touching memorial garden and museum exhibits that commemorate the Jewish community's resilience through history.

o6:00 PM Enjoy dinner with the group at a local restaurant. **o8:00 PM** Explore Budapest by night.










Day 7: Tuesday, March 24, 2026 - Szentendre, City Park and Heroes' Square

08:00-9:00 AM Enjoy breakfast at the hotel

og:oo AM Board bus to travel to **Szentendre** (about 1 hour)
Szentendre is a charming riverside town known for its colorful Baroque architecture, narrow cobbled streets, and vibrant art scene. It has a rich cultural heritage influenced by Serbian, Dalmatian, and Greek settlers, reflected in its many churches and museums.



02:00 PM Return to Budapest and visit **Budapest City Park** and **Vajdahunyad Castle**. Originally constructed in 1896 for Hungary's Millennial Exhibition, the park was designed by architect Ignác Alpár to showcase the evolution of Hungarian architecture. Visit **Heroes' Square** - a grand, iconic plaza featuring the towering Millennium Monument and statues of Hungary's most important national leaders, celebrating the country's thousand-year history.

05:00 PM Enjoy dinner with the group at a local restaurant. **07:00 PM** Explore Budapest by night









Day 8: Tuesday, March 25, 2026 - Aguaworld Resort, Citadella, Liberty Statue

10:00 AM Enjoy a swim day at the **Aquaworld Resort** (eat lunch at the resort)

02:00 PM Return to the hotel to change

03:30 PM Enjoy shopping in Váci Utca Shopping District

o6:00 PM Visit Citadella Fortress and Liberty Statue at sunset
